

RESOLUTION 2020-206

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY
AS A RESULT OF CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19),
CITY OF WALLACE, SHOSHONE COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of a Political Subdivision may renew or extend a declaration made by the Mayor of a Political Subdivision for a period in excess of seven (7) days; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor declared a State of Emergency within this Political Subdivision on the 18th Day of March, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the Governing Board of this City has determined that all findings made in the aforementioned declaration continue in existence at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council does hereby proclaim and declare a local disaster emergency continues to exist in the City and all declarations made under **RESOLUTION 2020-205** shall remain in full force and effect until the Centers for Disease Control and the Governor of the state of Idaho sound an end to the emergency or the City Council expressly authorizes the discontinuance of such Declaration, with the additional directives as follows:

- Changing date or method of holding council meetings, or use of video broadcasting of meeting (change of meeting time and place should be by ordinance)
- Restricting Access to certain public places
- Changing methods of bill payment or extending times for payment
- Limiting city building occupancy
- Establishing temporary rules for using parks or other city facilities
- Authorizing the Mayor, in consultation with the Council President, to establish other administrative policies necessary to protect the public health and safety

Adopted unanimously, in open session this 20th day of March 2020.
