

A livable community with a strong sense of history




HISTORIC PRESERVATION

Promote broad understanding of historic preservation and its benefits.






HISTORIC PRESERVATION

Update the city's website to include the most current inventory of historic properties and links to the State Historic Preservation Office webpage, relevant documents (e.g. design review application), and other related resources

COMMUNITY SURVEY



Water Facilities: Furnished by North West Light & Power Co. - Gravity system. Main supply from Placer Creek, 1 mi. S.W. of town, through Flum Creek, to 4' x 4' x 200' tank, elev. 70 give 50 lbs. press. - Emergency supply from Placer Creek by diverting dam 1 1/4 m from & elev. 300' abv. business portion of town, through 22" wood pipe to 153 High Sts., where gate connects this with main system. - Auxiliary supply from mountain springs through 12" x 12" flume to 40,000 gal tank 1/2 mi. S.E. of & elev. 300' abv. town. This supply East End & is shut off from main system by a gate.
26 cbl. hds. - Also 4 private standard hys. with hose.

Fire Dept.: - Partly paid organization. Chief & 2 drivers fully paid. - 30 call men divided into 5 companies.
1 hose cart with 1200' 2 1/2" hose & 1 combination chem truck (50 gal tk) each drawn by 2 horses. - 4 hose carts with 550', 500', 300', & 300' hose in reserve.
Barnwell fire alarm system. 20 boxes. During 1909, a fully paid one company dept. will be established.
Town level, except S. of Bank & Resident st's; that portion being built on mountain side.
Streets: unpaved. - Lights: elec.
Fire limits shown by heavy red line.
