Dear Resident,

Winter is approaching, and with winter comes lots of snow. Our goal is to keep the streets clear of snow for your safe travel and you can help. Working together we can prevent accidents and keep our streets and sidewalks clear of snow and safe for travel.

You can help us service you by doing the following:

- Prior to first snow, remove any inoperable vehicles and trailers from the streets.
- Adhere to street signage and do not park in areas posted with no parking signs. These signs are posted on narrow streets that we cannot drive our plows on when cars are parked in these areas. Cars parked in posted no parking areas will be ticketed and may be towed.
- If you see the plow coming down the street and you have the ability to move your vehicle, do so, and our plow will clear the curb for you. This will save you hard work, prevent your car from getting "plowed in" and prevent possible accidents. Our plows need to maintain a 3' distance around a parked car.
- Keep the sidewalks around your property clear of snow. When shoveling snow from the sidewalk surrounding your residential property, the snow should be disposed of in either your yard, in the median between the sidewalk and street, or shoveled from the curb all the way to the wind row in the center of the street taking care not to obstruct traffic. The City would like to remind all residents and business owners that Idaho Code § 18-3907 prohibits you from obstructing streets and roadways with snow or other materials. Take all necessary precautions in order to ensure that any snow you remove from your property or parking spaces is not placed in the street in a way that obstructs the flow of traffic, views of drivers, or blocks intersections. Violations of this code section constitute a misdemeanor.
